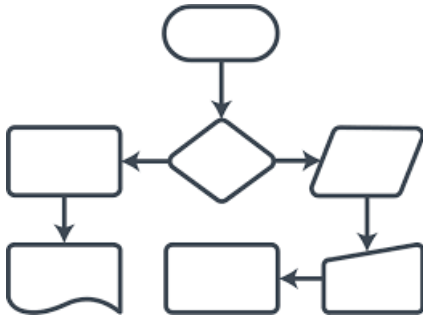

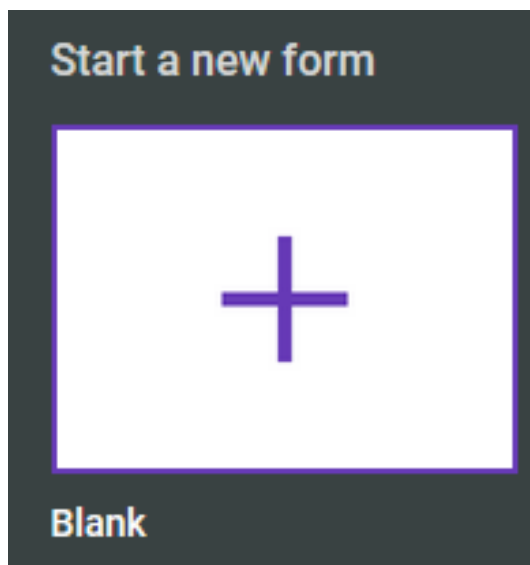
Creating a Threaded Form

The first step is actually: planning! This is critical as the different paths can get messy! Remember those Choose Your Own Adventure books? A threaded form works just like that. This gives opportunities for so many activities, but it does require a little bit of pen and paper planning first!

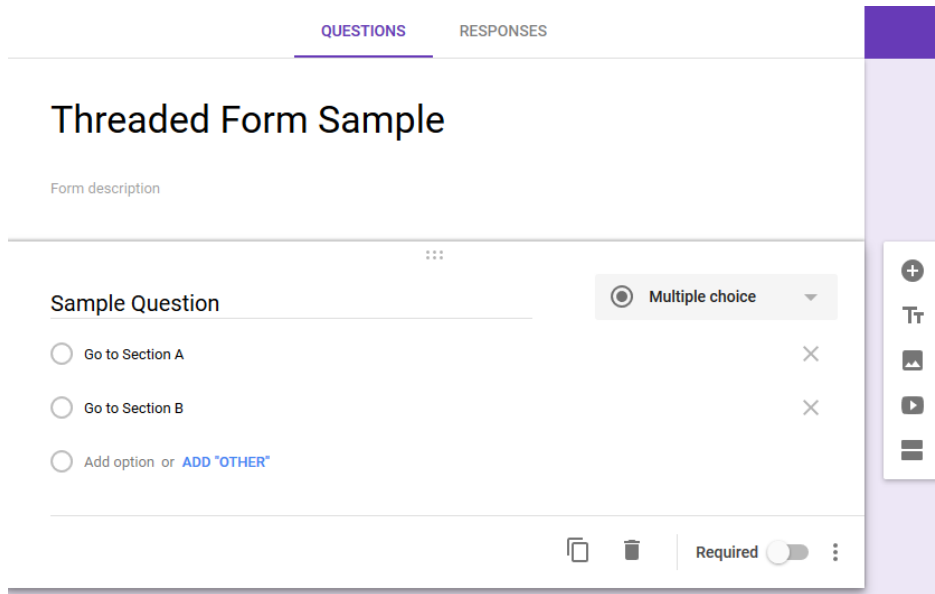


Creating a Thread:

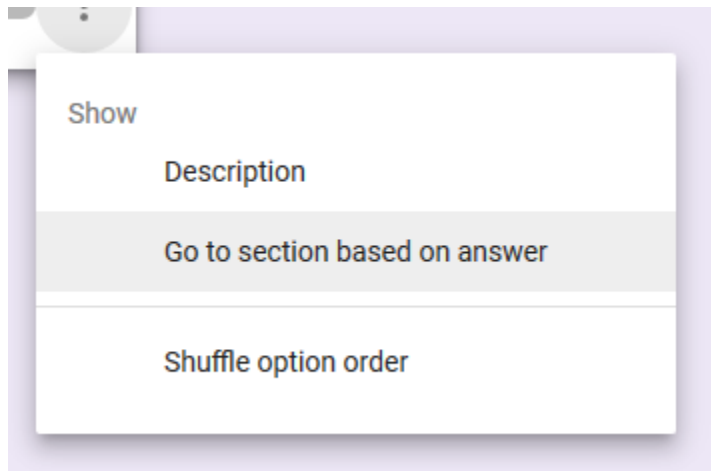
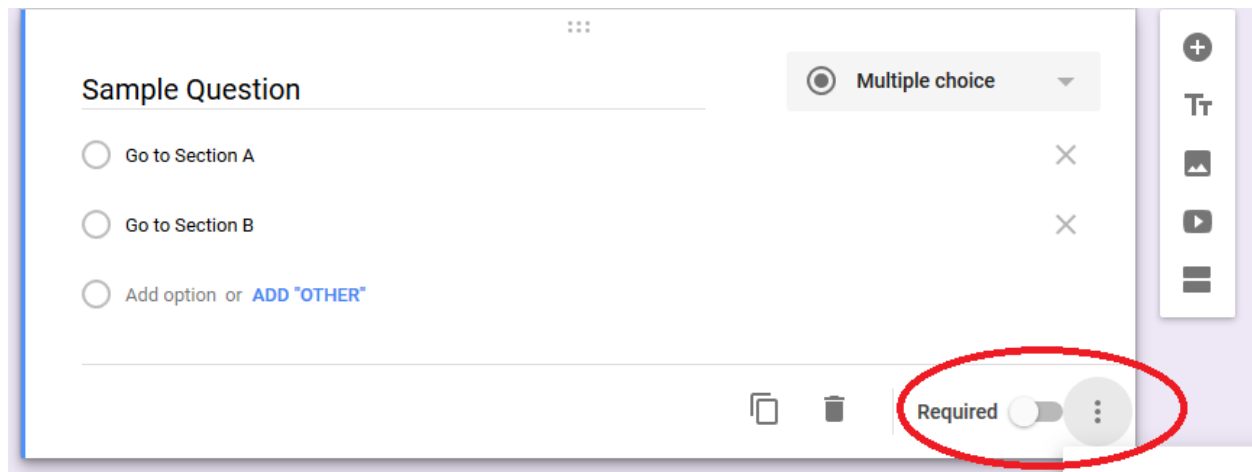
Step 1, Create a new form.



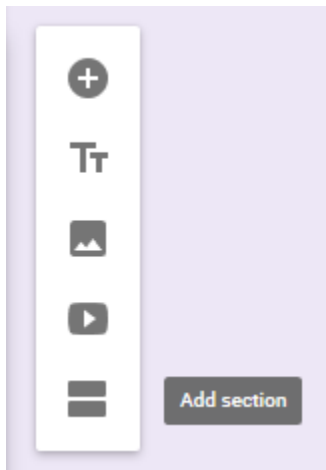
Step Two. Create a Multiple Choice Question.



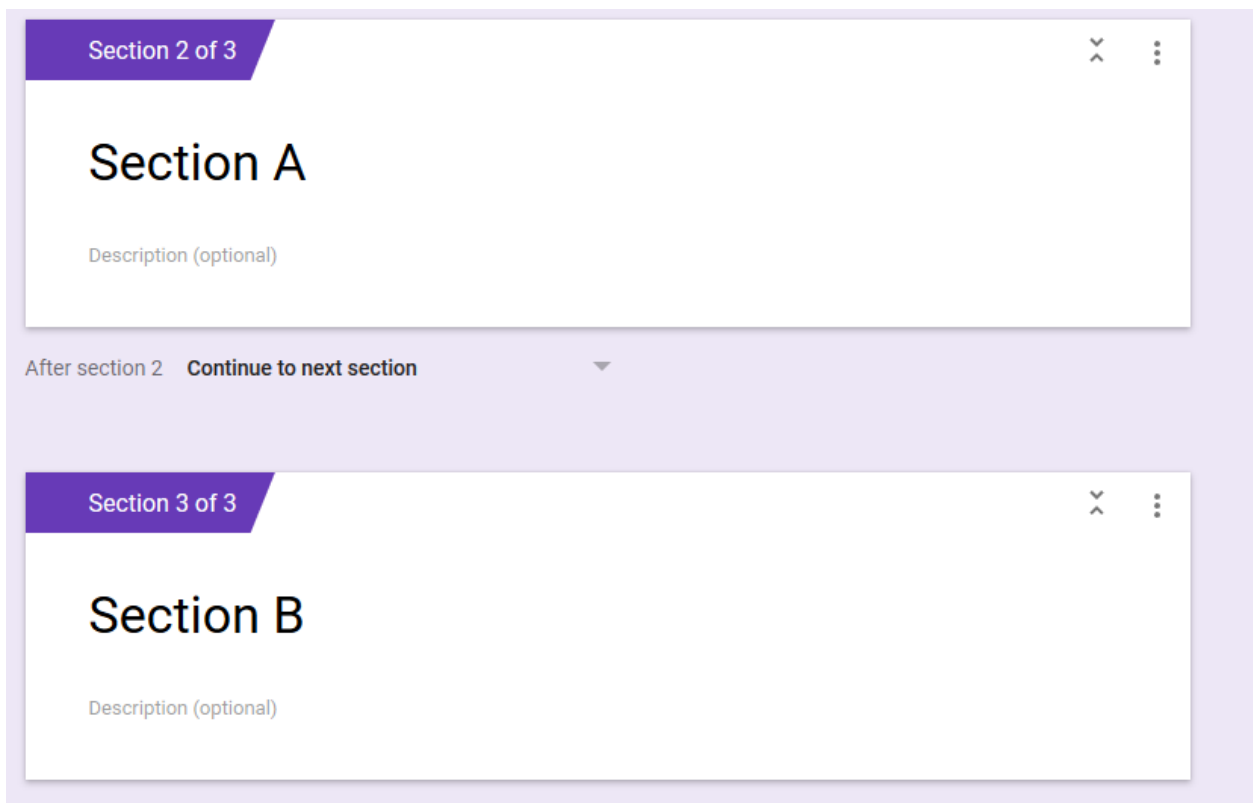
Step Three: In the bottom right corner of the question box, select 'Go to section based on answer.'



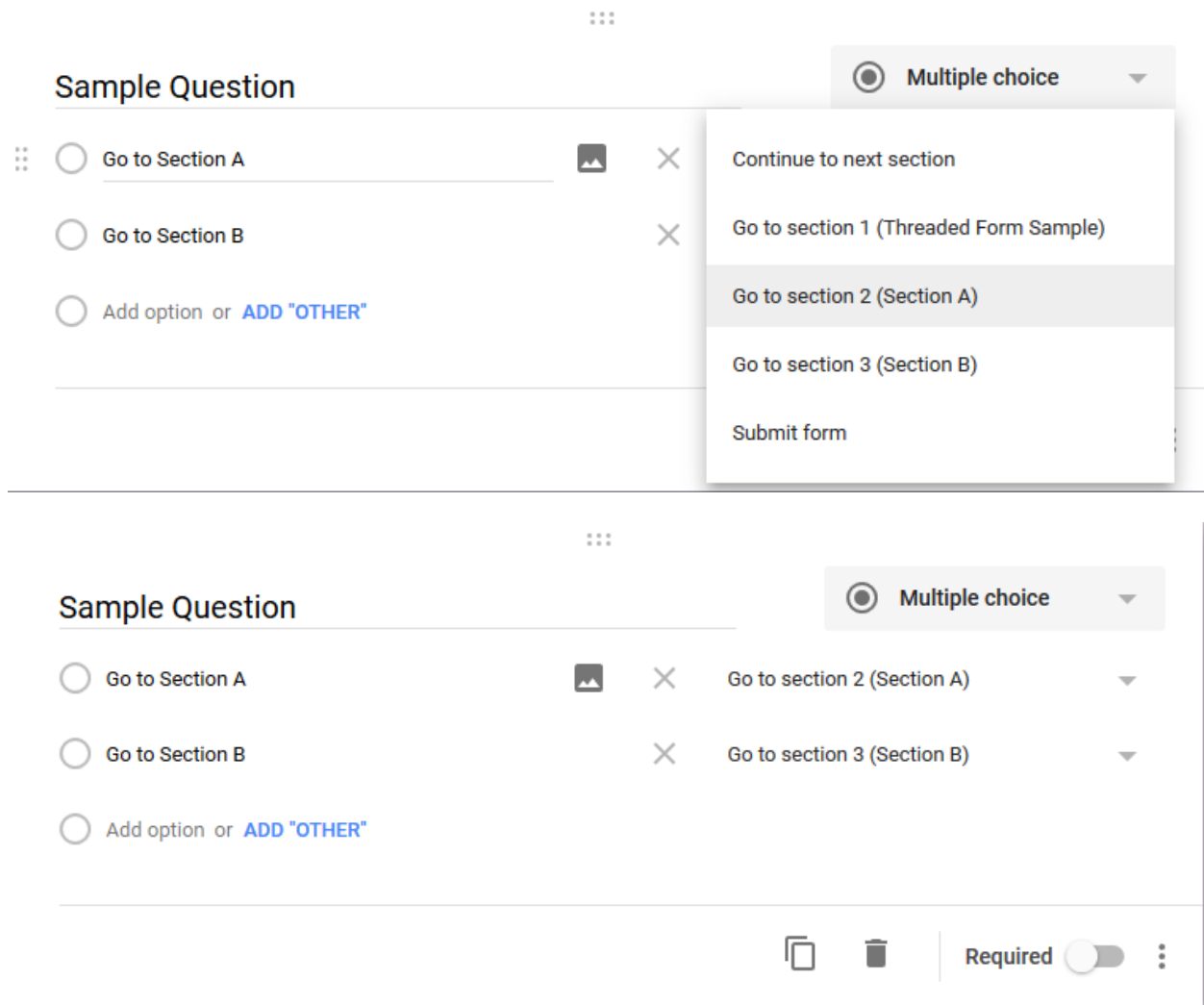
Step Four: In the right toolbar, add some new sections.



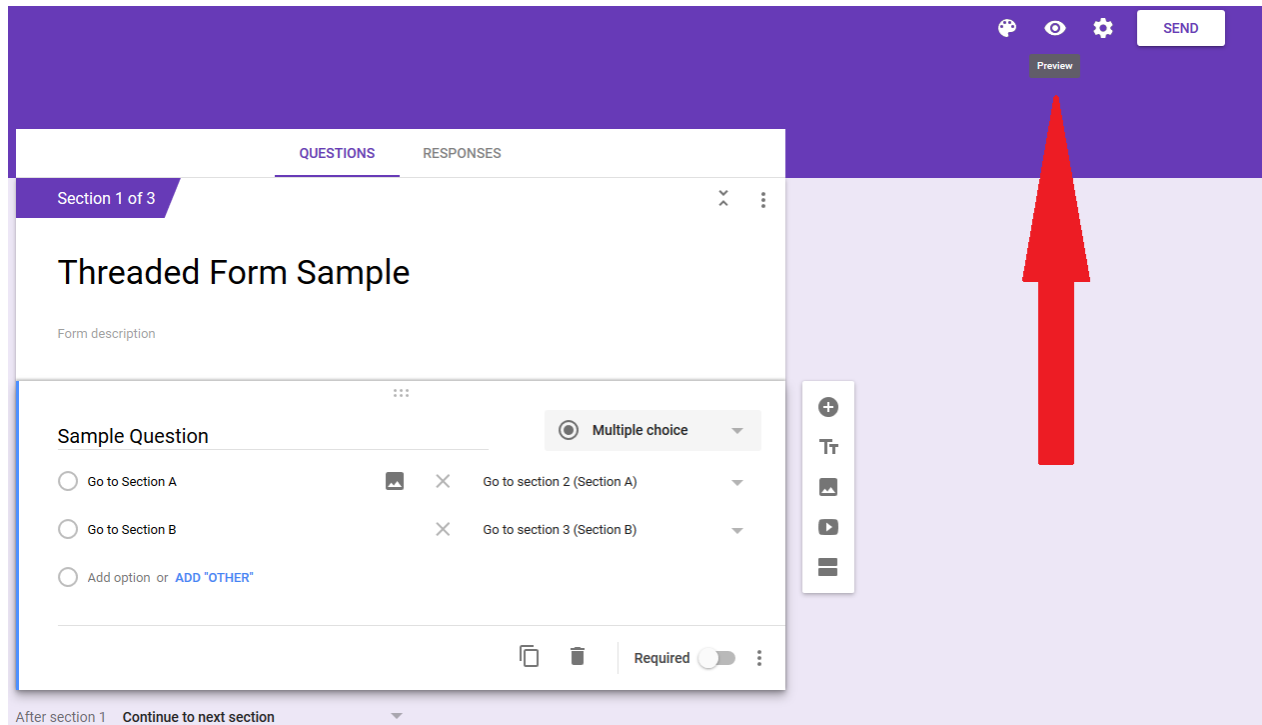
Step Five: Give these new sections a name.



Step Six: In your original question, select the 'continue to next section' drop down menu. You can now select which section this answer will go to.



Step Seven: Try it out to see if it works!
